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*To support this commitment, ACS offers several forms of financial assistance and tuition support, each with a distinct purpose, eligibility criteria, and review process.*

At ACS Doha, we believe that access to an excellent education should be guided by talent, commitment, and potential, not limited solely by financial circumstances. In alignment with the mission and values of Artemis Education, ACS is committed to fostering a diverse, inclusive, and high-performing learning community that reflects a wide range of backgrounds, experiences, and perspectives.

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Financial assistance at ACS is designed to remove barriers to access, support families during times of need, and ensure continuity of learning for students who are academically motivated or facing unforeseen challenges. While ACS is a tuition-based school, we recognize that financial circumstances can change, and that targeted financial support strengthens both individual families and the broader school community.

# Artemis Education Scholarships





## Artemis Education Scholarships

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*Artemis Academic Scholarships are merit-based awards recognizing students who demonstrate strong academic achievement, learning potential, and a commitment to excellence. These scholarships are competitive, limited in number, and awarded for one academic year, with continuation subject to annual review and reapplication*

The Artemis Academic Scholarship Program recognizes high-performing students who demonstrate strong academic achievement, intellectual curiosity, and the potential to contribute positively to the ACS learning community. These merit-based scholarships are competitive, limited in number, and provide partial tuition support of up to 50% for one academic year. The Artemis Academic Scholarship Program reflects Artemis Education's commitment to merit, opportunity, and academic excellence, supporting students who demonstrate both achievement and potential.

**Disclaimer:** Artemis Education and ACS Doha reserve the final authority on all scholarship decisions, awards, renewals, and interpretations of policy. Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of ACS and are subject to annual review and budget allocation.

**Note:** Semester 1 tuition fees are required to be paid in full in advance. Any financial aid awarded will be applied to Semester 2 fees and will be subject to review based on the student(s)' behavior and attendance.



## 01 Eligibility Criteria

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To be considered for an Artemis Academic Scholarship, applicants must meet all of the following criteria. Applicants must enroll for the full academic year and demonstrate strong academic performance, typically placing within the top 10% of their current school and/or on standardized assessments. Students may be asked to present a consistent academic record with a minimum overall grade of B and to maintain a positive behavioral record with no significant disciplinary concerns. Academic scholarships are limited in number, subject to annual budget allocation, not automatically renewable, reviewed annually, and open to students of all nationalities. Important: Scholarship discounts are applied to the second-semester tuition invoice only.

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## 02 Application Process

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Applicants must submit a complete application packet that includes official school reports from the two most recent academic years, evidence of a minimum overall grade of B, and confirmation of a positive behavioral record. Any additional diplomas, certifications, awards, or documented academic achievements may also be submitted and are encouraged as part of the overall review. As part of the application process, applicants will take an achievement test and must score at least in the 80th percentile to be considered for the scholarship. Applicants may also be asked to participate in a formal interview. The application deadline is May 1 of the academic year preceding the year of intended enrollment, and incomplete or late applications may not be considered.

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### **03 Scholarship Duration & Renewal**

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Academic scholarships are awarded for one academic year only and must be renewed annually. Renewal is not guaranteed, even if a student has previously received a scholarship. Students may be required to reapply each year as part of the renewal process. Academic scholarships may not be combined with any other discounts, including sibling, corporate, or other tuition reductions.

### **04 Scholarship Continuation Requirements**

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To maintain an academic scholarship, students must meet all required conditions throughout the academic year. Students are expected to maintain a minimum overall academic average of B, demonstrate a positive behavioral record, and maintain at least 95% attendance, with absences not exceeding five days per semester. Students must also show active participation in the school community. In addition, parents are expected to be active members of the Parent Support Organization (PSO). As scholarships are reviewed and renewed annually, families must submit a continuing application each year. Scholarships apply only while the student remains fully enrolled and in good standing and may be withdrawn if academic, behavioral, attendance, or enrollment conditions are not met. Tuition accounts must remain in good standing at all times. Failure to meet these requirements may result in the scholarship not being renewed or withdrawn.

# 03 Corporate Discounts





## Corporate Discounts

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*ACS maintains tuition discount agreements with select corporations, embassies, and partner organizations. These discounts support families relocating to Doha or employed by partner organizations and are governed by the terms of the relevant corporate agreement. Corporate discounts are subject to annual review and may not be combined with other forms of tuition reduction unless explicitly stated.*

Corporate Discounts at ACS are designed to support families who are affiliated with partner organizations and to strengthen relationships with employers, embassies, and institutions that share our commitment to education. Through formal agreements, these discounts help make enrollment more accessible for families relocating to Doha or employed by participating organizations, while also supporting a stable and diverse school community. Corporate discounts are governed by specific partnership terms, reviewed annually, and applied in accordance with school policy.

Organizations interested in establishing a corporate tuition discount with ACS may apply through a formal review process. To be considered, a business or organization should have at least 20 current students enrolled or prospective families actively applying to the school. Initial inquiries should be submitted in writing to the Admissions Office, which will coordinate a meeting with the organization's Human Resources representative to discuss employee interest, enrollment projections, and partnership expectations. Following this consultation, the proposal is reviewed in collaboration with the Finance Office, which provides final approval based on enrollment impact, financial considerations, and school policy. All corporate discounts are subject to annual review and formal agreement.

# 04 Financial Aid





## Financial Aid

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*Financial Aid is designed to support ACS's commitment to making a high-quality education accessible to students from a wide range of circumstances. This assistance may be offered to families whose financial situation presents a barrier to continued enrollment and is intended to provide timely, short-term support that helps ensure educational continuity. Financial Aid is reviewed on a case-by-case basis and is not intended as a long-term tuition reduction. It may be renewed yearly, based on an application process*

Financial Aid is intended to provide temporary tuition support to families whose financial circumstances present a barrier to continued enrollment at ACS. The purpose of this support is to promote access to a high-quality education while maintaining the long-term financial sustainability of the school. Financial Aid is not designed as a long-term tuition subsidy. Awards apply only to students enrolled for the full academic year and are reflected on the second-semester tuition invoice only.



## 01 Eligibility

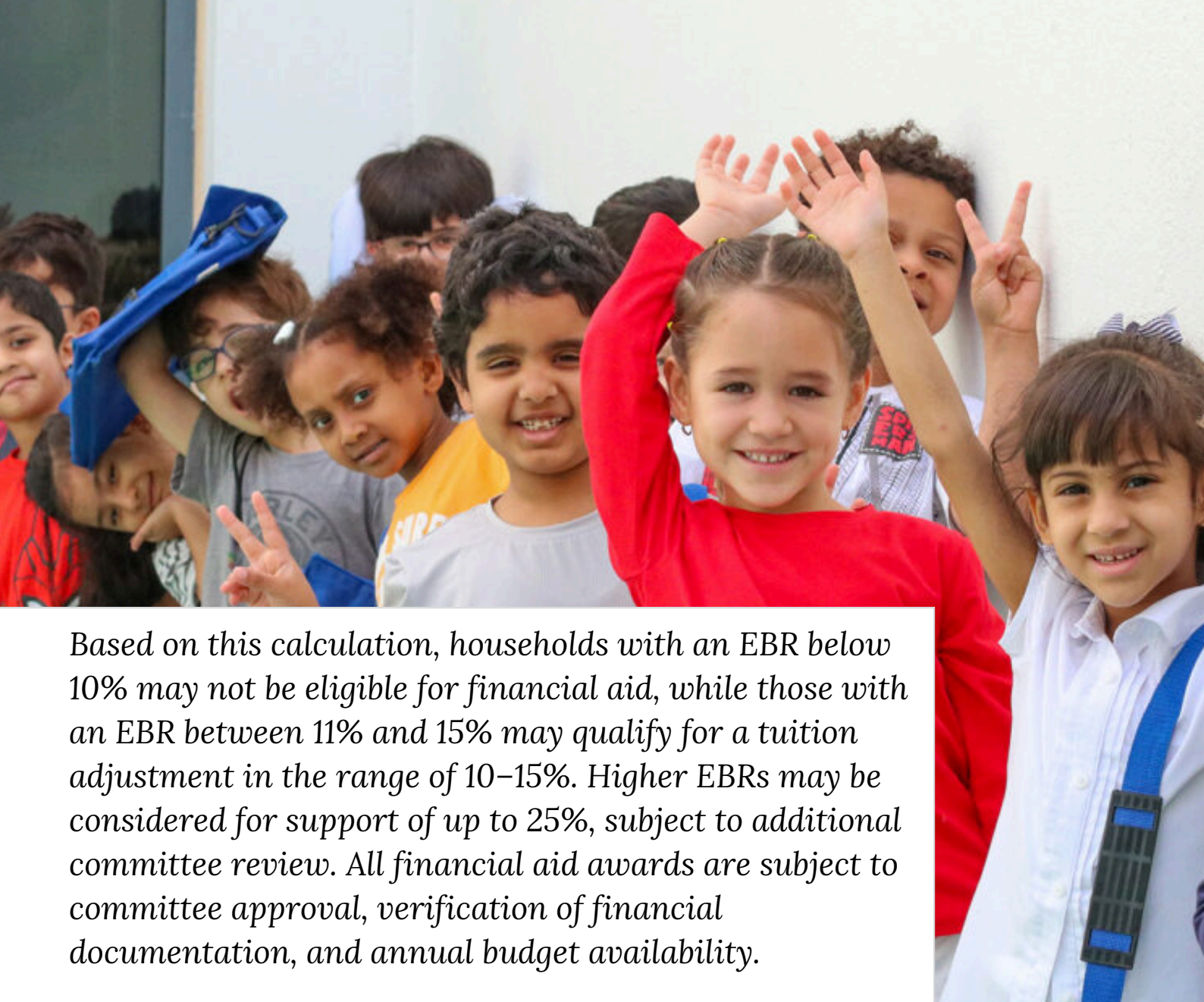
Financial Aid is available to both new and currently enrolled students and is reviewed on an individual basis. To be considered, families must meet the school's eligibility requirements and submit a complete and verifiable financial aid application. Required documentation includes salary certificates for both parents (where applicable), employer confirmation of any education allowance, three to six months of bank statements, copies of Qatar ID (QID), and a current tenancy contract or mortgage statement. Medical documentation may be required where applicable, along with any additional evidence supporting financial need. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed, and ACS reserves the right to conduct employer verification where appropriate.

## 02 Formula

Financial Aid eligibility is assessed using a comprehensive review of a family's Total Verified Household Income, which includes base salary, any cash-based housing allowance, averaged recurring bonuses, business income where applicable, and any employer-provided additional/other allowances. To ensure consistency and fairness, ACS uses an Education Burden Ratio (EBR) to evaluate the proportion of household income allocated to tuition. The EBR is calculated by dividing the annual tuition and fees amount (minus any employer education allowance and adjusted for applicable capital charges) by the total verified household income.

### Education Burden Ratio (EBR)

$$= \frac{(\text{Annual Tuition and Fees} - \text{Employer Education Allowance})}{\text{Total Verified Household Income}}$$



*Based on this calculation, households with an EBR below 10% may not be eligible for financial aid, while those with an EBR between 11% and 15% may qualify for a tuition adjustment in the range of 10–15%. Higher EBRs may be considered for support of up to 25%, subject to additional committee review. All financial aid awards are subject to committee approval, verification of financial documentation, and annual budget availability.*

## 01

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Financial Aid decisions at ACS take into account a family's overall financial profile as well as their tuition payment history. Priority is given to families who demonstrate a consistent payment record and do not have a pattern of chronic late payments. Families with prior unpaid balances or unresolved financial obligations to the school are not eligible for Financial Aid consideration.

## 02

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All Financial Aid applications and awards are reviewed by the Financial Aid Committee, which includes the Head of School, HFO, and a representative from Admissions. Committee decisions are discretionary, based on a holistic review of financial documentation and school policy, and are final.

## 03

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Financial Aid is temporary in nature and approved for a default period of one academic year. All awards are subject to structured annual review as part of the school's financial aid policy and budget cycle. Renewal is not automatic and requires a full reassessment, including the submission of updated financial documentation. Continued eligibility is contingent upon meeting all financial, academic, behavioral, and attendance expectations.

## 04

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Students receiving Financial Aid are expected to maintain satisfactory attendance. Absences may not exceed five days per semester or ten days per academic year. Excessive unexplained absences may result in a review of Financial Aid eligibility and may lead to a reduction or withdrawal of support at the Committee's discretion. Attendance exceptions are considered only in cases of documented medical or exceptional circumstances.

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## 05

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Semester 1 tuition fees are required to be paid in full in advance. Any financial aid awarded will be applied to Semester 2 fees and will be subject to review based on the student(s)' behavior and attendance.

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# Tuition Bursary





## Tuition Bursary

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*(For ACS Employees) - The Tuition Bursary is a need-based benefit available exclusively to eligible ACS employees to support the enrollment of their children at the school. This bursary is intended as an additional employment benefit, not a guaranteed entitlement or right. Tuition bursaries are subject to eligibility criteria, annual review, budget availability, and continued employment with ACS, and may be adjusted or withdrawn at the school's discretion.*

The Tuition Bursary program is an employment-related benefit offered by ACS to support eligible employees with the cost of enrolling their children at the school. The bursary program is designed to attract, support, and retain high-quality staff while ensuring that employee families remain active, contributing members of the school community. Tuition bursaries are provided at the discretion of the school and are not a guaranteed entitlement or right.



## **01 Overseas Hire Tuition Bursary**

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For eligible overseas-hired employees, a tuition bursary may be included as part of the employee's overall compensation and benefits package. The specific terms of the bursary, including eligibility, coverage, and duration, are outlined in the employee's individual employment contract or offer letter. Overseas hire tuition bursaries are contingent upon continued employment with ACS and compliance with all school policies.

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## **03 Conditions of Eligibility and Good Standing**

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All tuition bursaries are conditional upon students remaining in good standing with the school. This includes meeting academic expectations, maintaining a positive behavioral record, adhering to attendance requirements, and complying with all school policies and procedures. Bursaries may be reduced or withdrawn if a student or family fails to meet these expectations.

In addition, tuition bursaries are contingent upon the employee remaining in active employment with ACS. Changes in employment status, contract terms, or eligibility may result in a review or adjustment of the bursary.

## **02 Local Hire Bursary**

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ACS may also offer tuition bursaries to locally hired employees on a demonstrated financial need basis. These bursaries are reviewed individually and are subject to available funding, eligibility criteria, and annual review. Local hire bursaries are not automatic and require a formal application and supporting financial documentation.

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## **04 Review and Governance**

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All tuition bursaries are subject to annual review, budget availability, and approval through the school's established financial and administrative processes. The school reserves the right to amend, suspend, or withdraw tuition bursary support at its discretion.
